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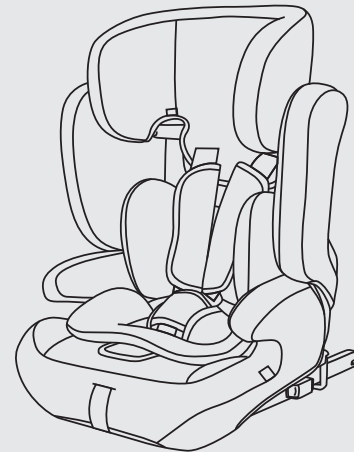

**ISOFIT** :FIX attachment for the connection between CRS and vehicle seats which has two rigid anchorages according to UN ECE 14, but use only for Group II, III.

### Notice

1. This is a “universal”and “semi-universal” child restraint,it is approved to Regulation NO.44,04 series of amendments,for general use in vehicles and it will fit most,but not all,car seats.
2. A correct fit is likely if the vehicle manufacturer has declared in the vehicle handbook that the vehicle is capable of accepting a “Universal”child restraint for this age group.
3. This child restraint has been classified as “Universal”under more stringent conditions than those which applied to earlier designs which do not carry this notice.
4. If in doubt,consult either the child restraint manufacturer or the retailer.

**Only suitable if the vehicle is fitted with 3-point safety belts,Approved to UN/ECE Regulation No.16 or other equivalent standards.**

### NOTICE

- This is an ISOFIX CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEM for group I with ISOFIX and top tether.It is approved to Regulation NO.44,04 series of amendments for general use in vehicles fitted with ISOFIX anchorages systems.
- It will fit vehicles with positions approved as ISOFIX positions(as detailed in the vehicle handbook),depending on the category of the child seat and of the fixture.
- The mass group and the ISOFIX size class for which this device is intended is:9-18kg,class B1

Seat positions in other cars may also be suitable to accept this child restraint.If in doubt,consult either the child restraint manufacturer or the retailer.

## 1. Vital information-READ NOW

For your child's safety, please read these instructions carefully before use and keep them for future reference. Failure to follow the instructions contained in this manual could result in serious injury to your child.

1. This child safety seat can only be used with the harness for children 9kg to 18kg in weight (group I: 9 - 18kg ; group II, III: 15-36 kg).
2. This instruction manual can be retained in the special space of the child seat for its life period.
3. Do not use this child safety seat at the home. It has not been designed for home use and should only be used in your car.
4. Never leave your child unattended in the child restraint system even for a short time.
5. The child safety seat should be changed when it has been subject to violent stresses in an accident.
6. This child restraint should be securely belted in the vehicle even when not in use. In a crash or sudden stop, an unsecured child safety seat may injure other occupants.
7. Always make sure that any straps holding the seat restraint to the vehicle shall be tight, any straps restraining the child should be adjusted to the child's body, and check that the straps shall not be twisted.
8. **IMPORTANT!** Ensuring that any lap straps is worn low down, so that the pelvis is firmly engaged.
9. Do not use any load bearing contact points other than those described in the instructions and marked in the child restraint, when in doubt, please contact the child restraint manufacturer..
10. Any luggage or other objects liable to cause injuries in the event of a collision shall be properly secured.
11. The rigid items and plastic parts of a child restraint must be so located and installed that they are not liable, during everyday use of the vehicle to become trapped by a moveable seat or in a door of the vehicle.

12. To prevent from the risk of fall, your child should always be fastened.

13. It is dangerous to make any alteration or additions to the device without the approval of the competent authority, and a danger of not following closely the installation instructions provided by the child restraint manufacturer.

14. This child safety seat is designed for children from 9 to 36 kg. Never overload the child safety seat more than one child or with other loads.

15. The child restraint must not be used without the cover.

16. The seat cover should not be replaced with any other than the one recommended by the manufacturer, because the cover constitutes an integral part of the restraint performance.

17. Before you adjust any movable or adjustable parts of your child safety seat, you must remove your baby from the child safety seat.

18. The child safety seat should be kept away from sunlight if the seat is not provided with a textile, otherwise it may be too hot for the child's skin.

19. Never use a second-hand product, as you can never be certain what was happened to it.

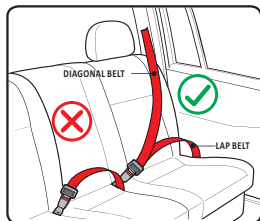
20. **Notice:** Do not use in any configuration not shown in the instructions.

21. Please identify unsatisfactory position of the adult safety belt buckle relative to the correct point of the child safety seat, if in doubt, please contact the child seat manufacturer.

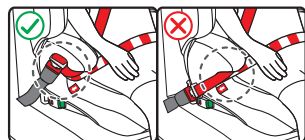
22. Please also read the car manufacturer's handbook before use.

23. **Importance!** Before using ISOFIX child restraint system, please read carefully the manual of automobile manufacturer about the instruction of ISOFIX fix point.

## 2. Safety instruction



Only suitable if the approved vehicles are fitted with 3 point safety-belts, approved to UN/ECE Regulation No.16 or other equivalent standards.



**NOTICE:** If the buckle strap of car seat is too long, the child restraint system can not be installed firmly. It is very dangerous. If any doubt, please consult the child restraint system manufacturer.

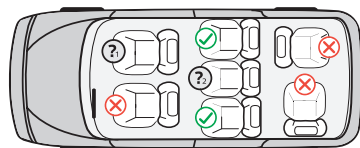

## 6 Steps of backrest and base assembly



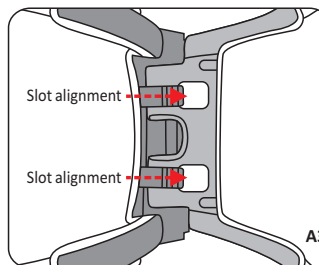
**Step 1:** Slide seat out of box

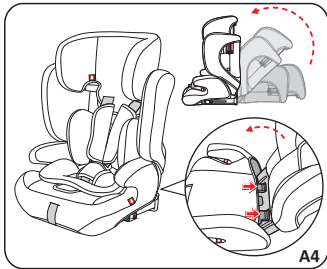
**Step 2:** Align base and backrest in a straight line.

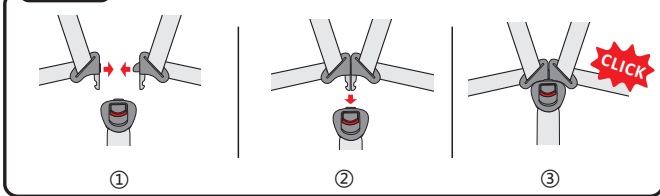

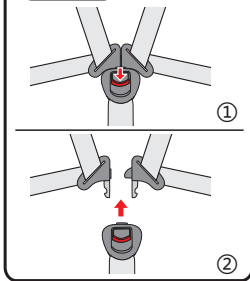

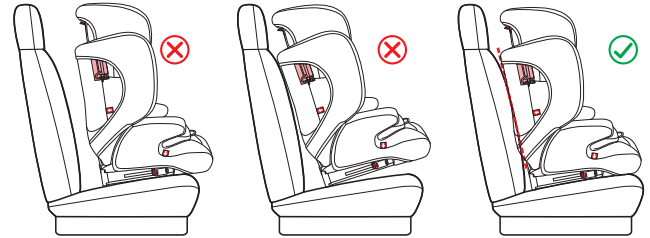
Align the left and right buckle tongues to one tongue and insert into the buckle until you hear a "Click" .

## 8. How to place the safety seat

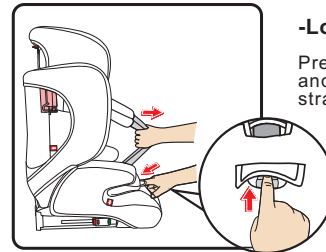
**⚠ Note:** In order to keep safety, please put the restraint system on the back seat, and ensure that the backrest and the car seat nicely.



## 9. Adjust the harness

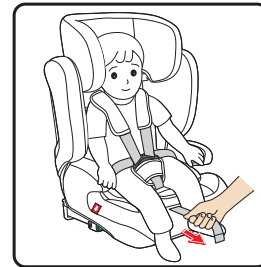
### -Loosening the shoulder harness

Press the adjuster button under the cover and at the same time pull both shoulder straps forward.



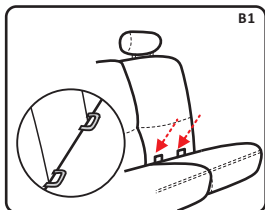
### -Tightening the harness

Pull the adjuster strap until the harness is fully tightened.

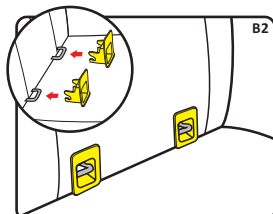


## 10. How to use the isofix guide

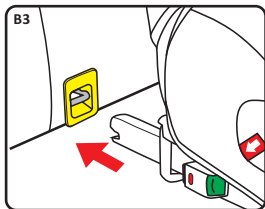
In order to lock the isofix connector to the steel point successfully, it can use isofix guide.



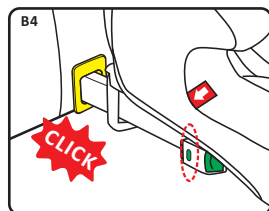
**Step 1:** Find out isofix connection in the car.



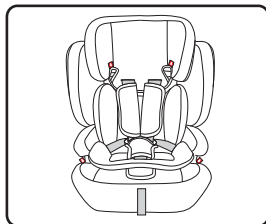
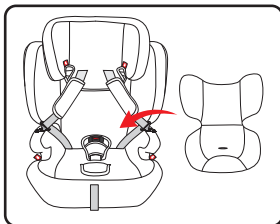
**Step 2:** Insert isofix guide into isofix connection



**Step 3:** Push child seat follow the direction and insert isofix connector into isofix guide(B3. B4) , Check if isofix locking system turns to green and make sure child seat is firmly connected(B4).



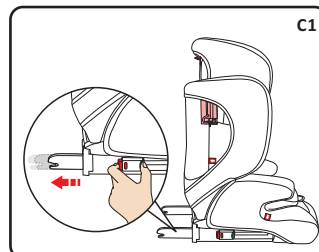
## 11. Instructions for use of cushion

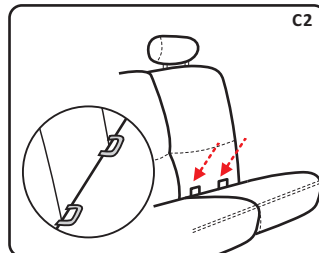

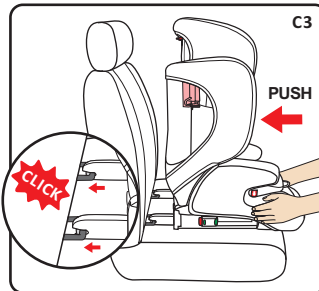
### 12.1 Install the baby car seat

**Step 1:** Press both button and push out the isofix connector

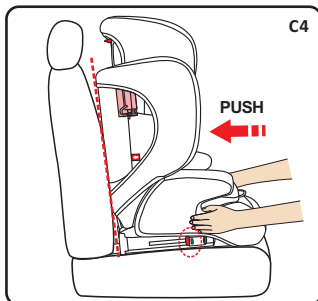

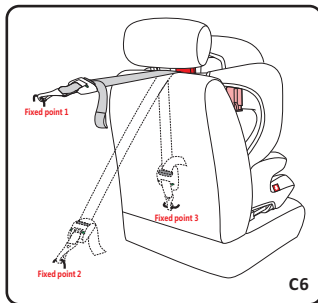
**Step 4:** Check if isofix locking system turns to green and make sure child seat is firmly connected(C4).

**NOTICE:** Child safety seat must be against the car seat firmly.



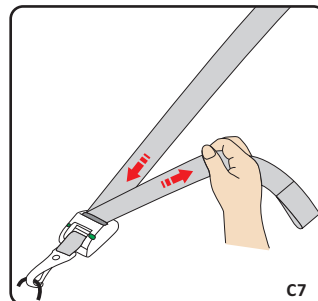

**Step 5:** Press the adjusting button and adjust the belt of top tether to the longest(C5).



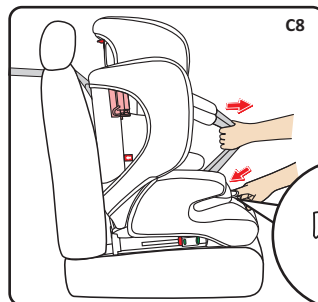
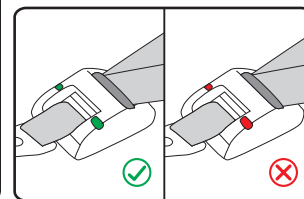

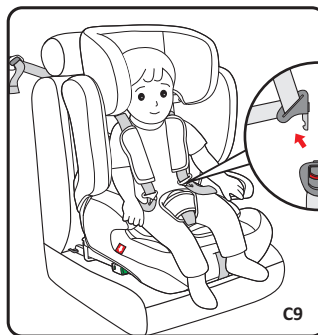
**Step 7:** String the belt of top tether until the adjuster shows green(C7).

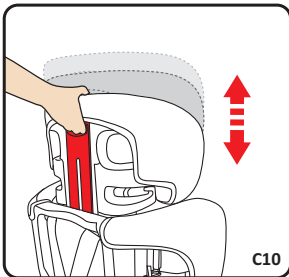
**12.2 Securing the child in the safety car seat.**

**Step 1.** Loosen the harness(C8)



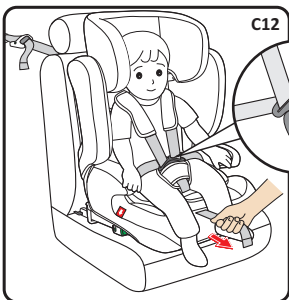
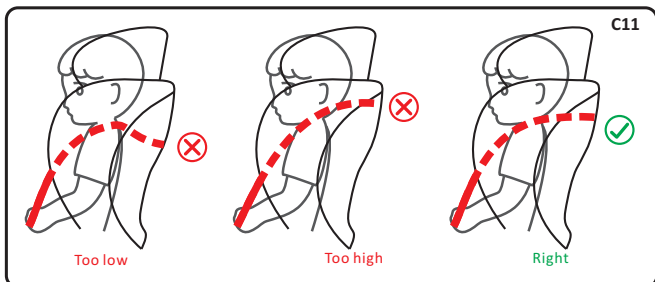

**Step 2:** Release the buckle, and put the child into the safety car seat(C9).



**Step 3:** Pull the height adjuster to adjust the height of the harness and the headrest according to the child's height(C10).

**⚠️ Note!** The height for the harness is adjusted by lifting the headrest(C11).

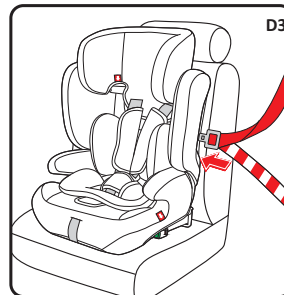
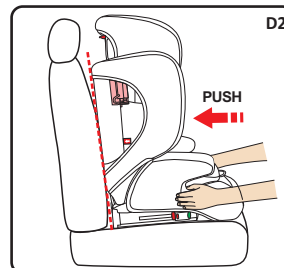
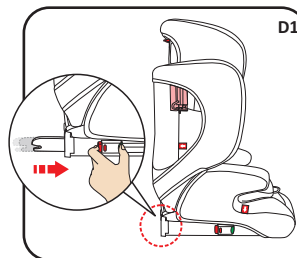


**Step 4.** Align the left and right buckle tongues to one tongue and insert into the buckle until you hear a “Click”(C12).

**Step 5:** Pull the shoulder straps upwards to remove the slack from the lap sections of the harness then pull the adjuster strap until the harness is fully tightened(C12).

It is suitable for the weight 9-18 kg, given to children about 9months-4 years old.



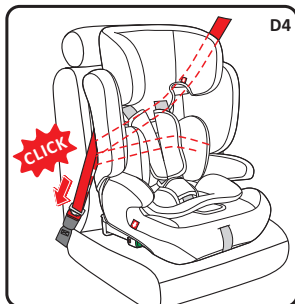
### 13.1 Install the baby car seat

**Installation:** 3-point safety belt  
**Securing the child:** 5-point harness

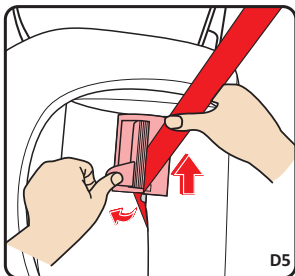
**Step 1:** Hide isofit in the booster(D1).

**Step 2:** Put the Child safety seat against the car seat(D2)

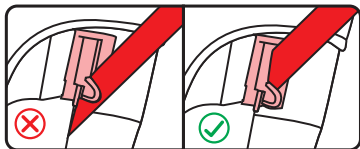
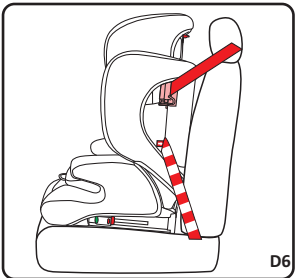
**Step 3:** Pull out the diagonal belt together with lap belt, through the belt route slot of backrest(D3).



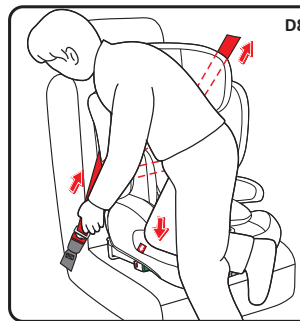
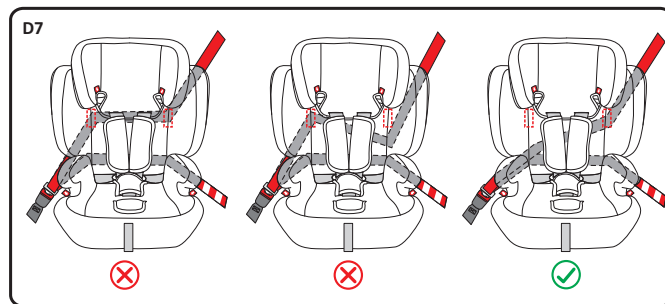
**Step 4:** Insert into car seat belt buckle hear a “CLICK” (D4).



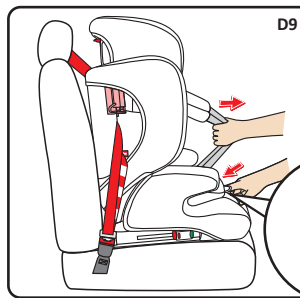
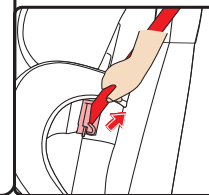
**Step 5:** Clip the diagonal belt into the locking clip. (D5, D6, D7) .



**Note!** Please refer to the following picture, clip the safety belt into the locking clip in the right way (C6, C7)

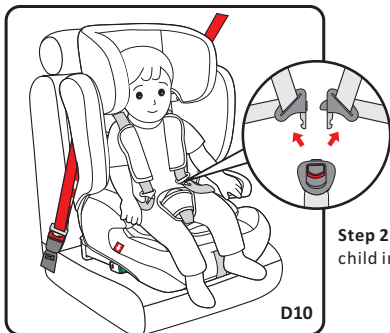


**Step 6:** Pull car seat belt follow the direction of red arrow and make sure the belt is tight enough (D8).



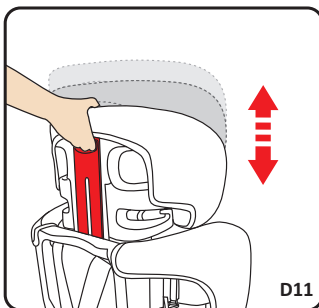
### 13.2 Securing the child in the safety car seat.

**Step 1.** Loosen the harness (D9)



**Step 2:** Release the buckle, and put the child into the safety car seat (D10).

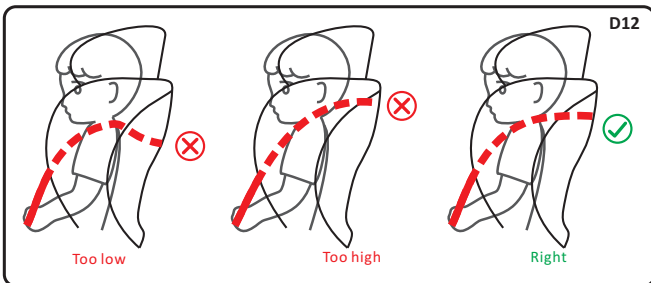

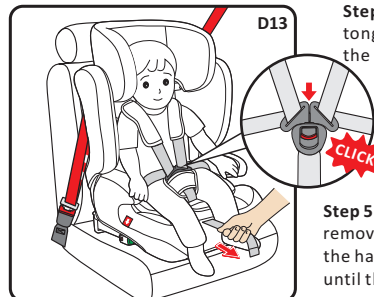

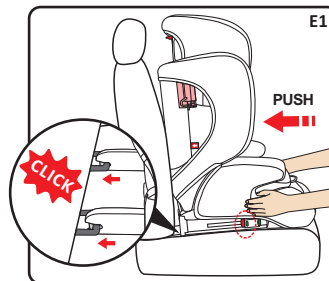
**Step 4.** Align the left and right buckle tongues to one tongue and insert into the buckle until you hear a "Click" (D13).

## 14. Installing the safety group II, III

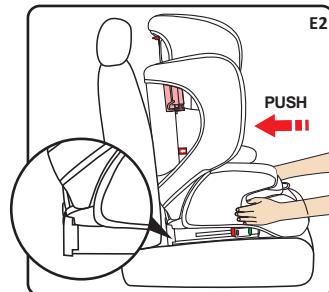
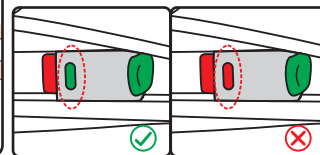
It is suitable for the weight 15-36 kg, for children about 4-12 years old Approx. Group II, III installation can choose to use ISOFIT or not.

Connect ISOFIT with anchorage point on the car seat (E1)

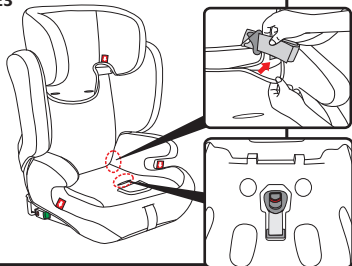

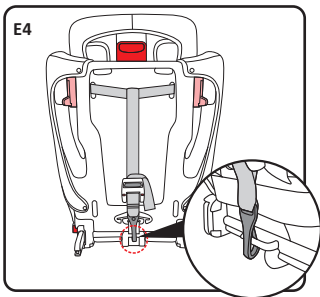
### Securing the child

**Step 1:** Follow the part 15 (see picture F1~F9) routine to remove car seat pad.

**NOTICE 1:** Fold the strap of both sides and hide under the booster cover

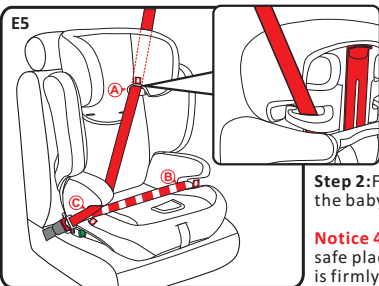
**NOTICE 2:** Place the buckle in the booster (under the cover).

**NOTICE 3:** No need to take off the top tether. Click it onto the booster.

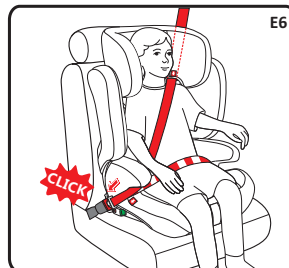

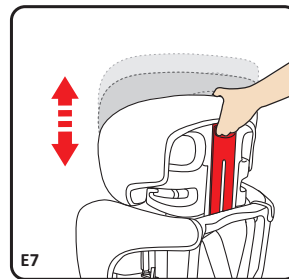
**Step 2:** Follow the E5 routine to install the baby car seat.

**Notice 4:** Stock the baby car seat in a safe place or ensure the baby car seat is firmly installed when not using it.

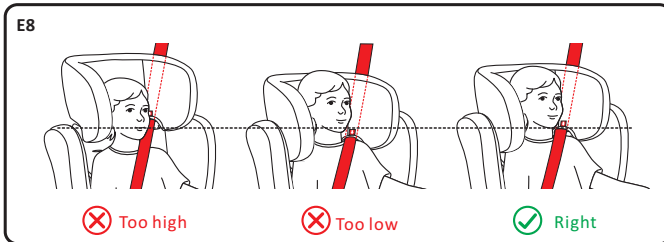

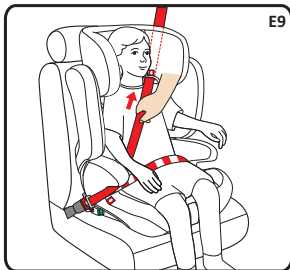


**Step 3:** Put the child in the seat and follow E5 routine.



**Step 4:** Use the height adjuster to adjust the height of the headrest according to the child's height. The gap between head belt guide and baby is 2 finger width. The harness straps should be level with or just above the child's shoulders (E7, E8).

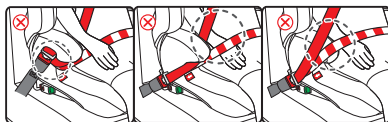

**Step 5:** Fasten car seat belt and make sure, it is tight enough(E9).

**Important:** Ensuring that any lap straps is worn low down, so that the pelvis is firmly engaged, shall be stressed.

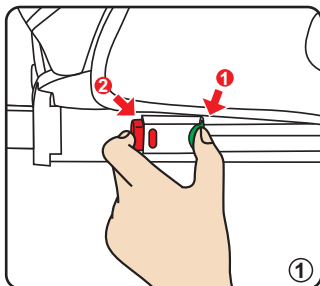

**Step 2:** Release the buckle

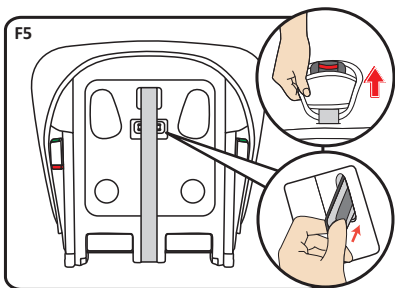

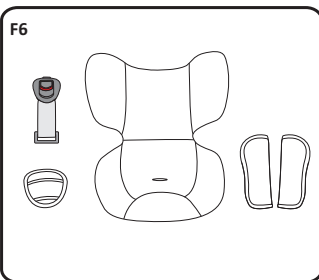
**Step 3:** Slide both of the harness straps off the harness connector.



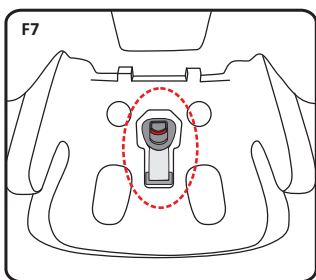
**Step 4:** Pull out the shoulder belt .



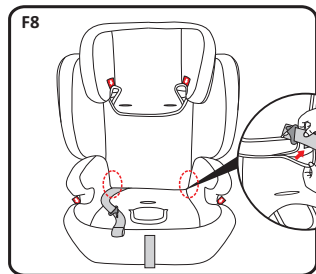

## 17. Maintenance and cleaning

### 17.1 Daily maintenance

1. In daily use, check periodically the child seat. The child seat should be replaced after an accident.
2. Please keep this child seat in dry and ventilated place to avoid damp moldy.
3. If the child seat becomes dusty, clean the seat belt and the plastic pieces by swiping them with a damp sponge and let it dry naturally.
4. If food or drink drop accidentally on the buckle, disassemble the seat belt from the child seat and rinse it gently by warm water. Leave it dry naturally.
5. For cleaning the entire child seat fabric cover, please refer to the 17.2 washing instructions.

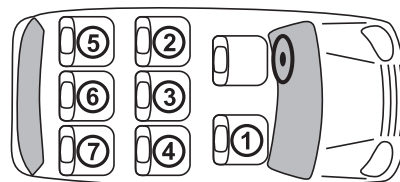
### 17.2 Washing instruction







