- Ensure that all parts are locked in place correctly and not penned in the adjustable seat or doors.
- Luggage or other objects liable to cause injuries in the event of a collision shall be properly secured.
- The child car seat not be used without the cover.
- The seat cover should not be replaced with any other than the one recommended by the manufacturer.
- Periodically inspect the harness, pay particular attention to attachment points, stitching and adjusting devices.
- Do not continue to use the child car seat if parts have become damaged or have loosened after an accident.
- Any straps holding the restraint to the vehicle should be tight. That
 any straps restaining the child should be ahjusted to the child's body,
 and that straps should not be twisted.
- Not to use any load bearing contact points other than those described in the instructions and marked in the child car seat.
- The importance of ensuring that any lap is worn low down, so that the pelvis is firmly engaged, shall be stressed.

Washing

The cover can be removed and washed with a mild detergent using the washing machine's cycle for delicate items $(30^{\circ}C)$.

Please observe the instructions on the waching label of the cover.Do not spin, and never tumble dry in an electric clothes dryer(the fabric may separate from the padding).



- This is "Universal" child restraint; it is approved to ECE Regulation 44.04 for general use in vehicles and will fit most, but not all vehicle seats.
- A correct fit is likely if the vehicle manufacturer has declared in the vehicle handbook that the vehicle is capable of accepting a "Universal" child restraint of this group.
- 3. This child restraint has been declared "Universal" under more stringent conditions than applied to earlier design which do not carry this notice.

- 8. The main load bearing contact points on the restraint are marking on the instruction. Please contact us if in doubt about this point


Only suitable if the vehicle is fitted with 3 point safety belts, approved to UN/ECE Regulation No.16 or other equivalent standards.

- This child seat can only be installed forward facing using a three point safety belt.
- Before each journey check whether the child car seatisinstall firmly.
- ◆ Do not change the child car seat any way.
- ◆ Do not leave your child unattended in the seat at any time.
- Protect the child restraint system against direct sun light other wise the high temperature will hurt your child.
